Course Description/ Overview

The Academic Integrity Tutorial offers students dynamic content and promotes understanding of academic integrity concepts, policies, and research methods to support coursework. The Tutorial consists of six modules:

- Academic Integrity: What It Is and Why It Matters
- Assignments and Expectations: Starting Out on the Right Track
- Writing Well with Sources: Developing Authentic Synthesis
- Giving Credit Where Credit is Due: Attribution and Citation
- Collaboration Without Copying: How to Do Authentic Work in a Group Setting
- Keeping Yourself Safe Online

Each module includes comprehensive and streamlined training to teach the fundamentals of academic integrity and techniques to avoid academic dishonesty. Implementing an interactive approach, students will learn to identify acts of academic dishonesty; methods in which to avoid intentional or unintentional plagiarism; resources to use for proper citation; and techniques to improve critical thinking skills.
