Course Description/ Overview

This session employs three hour-long sessions of comprehensive and streamlined training to teach the fundamentals of academic integrity and techniques to avoid academic dishonesty. Implementing an interactive approach, students will learn to identify acts of academic dishonesty; methods in which to avoid intentional or unintentional plagiarism; resources to use for proper citation; and techniques to improve critical thinking skills. The course consists of videos demonstrating the importance of maintaining academic integrity, a structured tutorial, multiple discussions, interactive lessons, and three additional quizzes. Upon completion of this course, students will receive certification from the Director of Educational Resources acknowledging clear understanding of academic integrity.
