I did have one however, who insisted it was correct because it had been used for multiple semesters, even though it was clearly a wrong answer. Overall I like the school, just find that the standard has been lowered. I like having high students in the course just hope by them being there the bar isn't lowered. It will ill prepare them for the future.
