COLLEGE POLICY: 502

CLASSIFICATION OF STUDENTS

Students who have earned fewer than 30 semester hours of credit are freshmen. Students who have earned at least 30 semester hours of credit are sophomores.

- 1. Degree-Seeking Students students who are enrolled in an associate's degree program.
- 2. Certificate-Seeking Students (Technical Certificates) students enrolled in a course of study that is at least three semesters.
- 3. Certificate of Proficiency Students students enrolled in courses of study that are two semesters or less.

NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS

- 1. Adult Education Students students who are working toward improving their English speaking skills, personal improvement, or obtaining their GED.
- 2. Transitory Students students enrolled in coursework for transfer, personal enrichment or work-related enhancement.
- 3. Concurrent Students students who are in secondary school who have met all concurrent enrollment criteria.
- 4. Secondary Career Center Students students who are enrolled in the specialized coursework for secondary courses who may not meet all concurrent criteria.
