Cybersecurity/Artificial Intelligence Instructor

(Full-Time, 9-Month Faculty/Renews Annually/Nashville Campus)

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE

The Cybersecurity/Artificial Intelligence Instructor will teach a combination of at least five in-person and/or online courses per semester to both secondary and/or post-secondary students; develop curriculum and instructional materials for courses as needed; evaluate student performance by following UAC's assessment plan; engage with business and industry representatives; facilitate and maintain relationships with other colleges within the CyberLearn consortium; participate in grant writing and administration; advise program students; and attend recruiting events. This is a full-time, on-campus position requiring 30 hours per week, typically Monday through Thursday, with occasional Friday meetings. Some travel is required.

REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in cybersecurity, computer science, or related field with at least 5 years of in-field experience OR Master's degree in cybersecurity, computer science, or related field.
- Previous teaching experience preferred.

ANNUAL SALARY

\$58,000 to \$68,000 range, depending on education and experience, plus an excellent benefits package that includes health, dental, and life insurance; short- and long-term disability insurance; a retirement plan with employer matching; paid vacation and sick leave; and educational assistance for employees and their dependents.

All applications must include a cover letter, an updated resume, copies of certifications held (if any), and unofficial transcripts. Applications received without the required documents will be incomplete and will not be considered for the position.
